

DRAFT ORDER

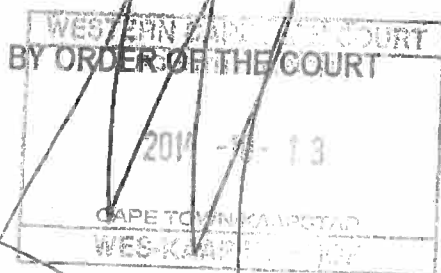

The Court, having heard counsel and having read the documents filed of record

**IT IS ORDERED:**

1. That the above named Respondent be placed in provisional liquidation in the hands of the Master of the above Honourable Court;
2. That a *Rule Nisi* do issue calling upon the Respondent and all interested parties to give reasons, if any, on Friday 14 November 2014 as to why:

- 2.1 The above named Respondent should not be placed in final liquidation in the hands of the Master of the above Honourable Court, and;
- 2.2 The costs of this application should not be costs in the liquidation of the above named Respondent.
3. That service and publication of the provisional liquidation order and *Rule Nisi* granted in terms of paragraphs 1 and 2 above shall be effected as follows;
- 3.1 That a true copy thereof shall be served on the Respondent at its registered address by the Sheriff or his deputy;
- 3.2 That a true copy thereof shall be served on the Receiver of Revenue by the Sheriff or his deputy;
- 3.3 That a true copy thereof shall be served by the Sheriff or his deputy on the employees of the company (if any) and on every registered trade union that may represent same in terms of section 346A of the Companies Act No. 61 of 1973 read with item 9 of Schedule 5 of the Companies Act No. 71 of 2008;
- 3.4 That a true copy thereof shall be published in one edition each of the "Cape Times" and "Die Burger" newspapers.
