- 4.3 Served on the employees of the respondent by affixing a copy thereof to any notice board to which the employees have access inside the respondent's business premises at 2nd Floor, Harrington House, 37 Barrack Street, Cape Town or if there is no access to the premises by affixing a copy to the front door of the respondent's business premises at 2nd Floor, Harrington House, 37 Barrack Street, Cape Town
- 4.4 Served on the South African Clothing and Textile Workers Union at Industria House, 350 Victoria Road, Salt River, Cape Town.
- 4.5 Served on the South African Revenue Services at 22 Hans Strijdom Avenue, Cape Town.
