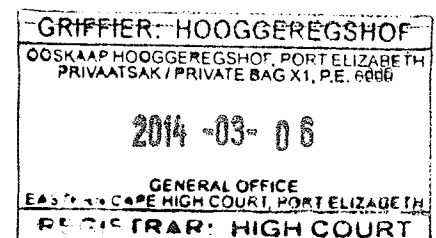
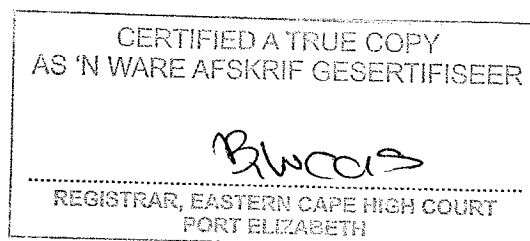

Having heard Advocate Veldsman, Counsel for the Applicant, and having read the documents filed of record.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Respondent Company be and is hereby placed in Provisional Liquidation in terms of Section 344(f) as read with Section 345(1)(a) of the Companies Act No. 61 of 1973, alternatively that the Respondent Company be and is hereby placed in provisional liquidation in terms of Section 344(f) as read with Section 345(1)(c) of the Companies Act No. 61 of 1973;
2. That a *rule nisi* do hereby issue calling upon all interested persons to show cause, if any, to this Court on TUESDAY, 8 APRIL 2014 at 09h30 or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, why a final order of liquidation should not be granted;



3. That service of the provisional order of liquidation be effected:

3.1 By the Sheriff of this Court on Respondent at its registered office
at corner of Lower Magennis and Mel Brooks Avenue,
Uitenhage, Eastern Cape;

3.2 By the Sheriff of this Court on the office of South African
Revenue Service, Port Elizabeth;

3.3 On all known creditors of Respondent by way of registered mail;

3.4 By the Sheriff on this Court on the employees of Respondent by:

3.4.1 Serving on the registered Trade Union that represents
the Respondent's employees; and

3.4.2 By affixing the application to the notice board at
Respondent's premises;

4. That the provisional order of liquidation be published in The Herald
and Die Burger newspapers;

5. That the costs of this application be costs in liquidation.
