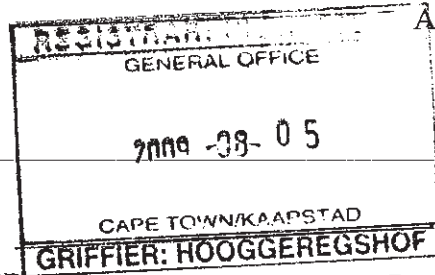

  - 2.1. the respondent should not be placed under final liquidation; and

- 2.2. the costs of this application should not be costs in the liquidation.

  - 3.1. at the registered office of the respondent, 42 Malherbe Street, Wellington, Western Cape;
  - 3.2. by publication in a copy of each of the Cape Times and Die Burger newspapers;
  - 3.3. on the employees of the respondent in accordance with s346A of the Companies Act 61 of 1973 ("the Act");
  - 3.4. on any trade union with which the respondent's employees are affiliated in accordance with s346A of the Act; and
  - 3.5. on the South African Revenue Service.
