ORDER

Having heard Counsel for the Applicant and having read the papers filed of record,
the following order is made:

1. The Applicant is placed under provisional liquidation in the hands of the Master of the High Court, who is to appoint a provisional liquidator to take charge of the Applicant's business;
2. A rule *nisi* is issued calling upon all persons concerned to appear and show cause, if any, to this Honourable Court at 10h00 on FRIDAY the 11th day of MARCH 2011, why a final order of liquidation should not be granted, and why the costs of this application should not be costs in the winding-up;

3. Service of this order is to be effected:

- 3.1 By the Sheriff upon the Applicant's employees at the Applicant's principal place of business at Shop 349, Somerset Mall, Somerset West;
- 3.2 By Sheriff upon any trade union which the Sheriff may establish represents any employees of the Applicant;
- 3.3 By the Sheriff upon the South African Revenue Services at 22 Hans Strijdom Street, Cape Town;
- 3.4 By publication in one edition of each of the Cape Times and Die Burger newspapers;
- 3.5 By prepaid registered mail to all known creditors of the Applicant with claims against it in excess of R5000.00.
