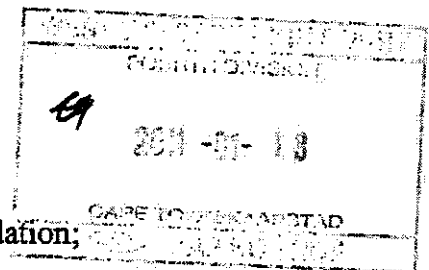

ORDER

Having heard counsel for the applicant, and having read the documents filed of record,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The respondent is placed under provisional liquidation;
2. A rule *nisi* is issued calling upon all interested persons to show cause, if any, to this Court at 10h00 on Tuesday, 1 March 2011 why :
 - 2.1. the respondent should not be placed under final liquidation; and
 - 2.2. the costs of this application should not be costs in the liquidation.



3. Service of this shall order be effected:

- 3.1. at the respondent's registered address at 7th Floor, ⁵St. George's Street, St. George's Mall, Cape Town;
- 3.2. by one publication in each of the Cape Times and Die Burger newspapers;
- 3.3. on the respondent's employees (if any) at 82 Molteno Road, Higgovale, Cape Town in the manner prescribed in section 346A of the Companies Act 61 of 1973 ("the Act");
- 3.4. on any trade union representing the respondent's employees in the manner prescribed in Section 346A of the Act;
- 3.5. on the South African Revenue Service.
