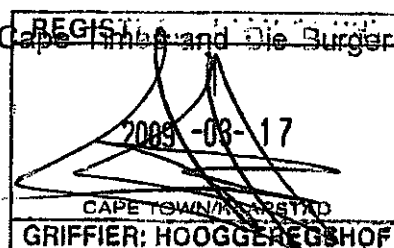

1. The Respondent is placed under a winding up Order in the hands of the Master of the High Court, in terms of the Companies Act 61 of 1973 as amended and made applicable in terms of section 66 of the Close Corporations Act 69 of 1984;
2. A rule nisi is issued calling upon the Respondent close corporation and all interested persons to show cause, if any, to this Court at 10h00 on **TUESDAY** the 21st day of **APRIL 2009** why a final winding up order should not be granted and why the costs of this Application should not be costs in the winding up;
3. That service of this order be effected:
 - 3.1 At the registered office of the Respondent;
 - 3.2 By publication in one edition each of the ~~Cape Times~~ and ~~Die Burger~~ Newspapers;



3.3 On the South African Revenue Services;

3.4 On the employees of the Respondent insofar as may be possible in the circumstances;

3.5 On all creditors with claims above R5 000.00.
