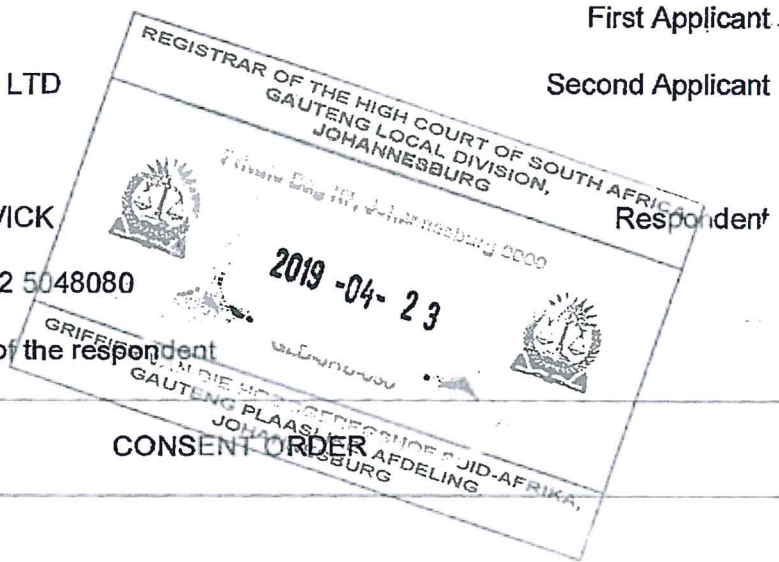

HAVING heard counsel for the parties and having read the documents filed of record,
by agreement between the parties it is ordered that:

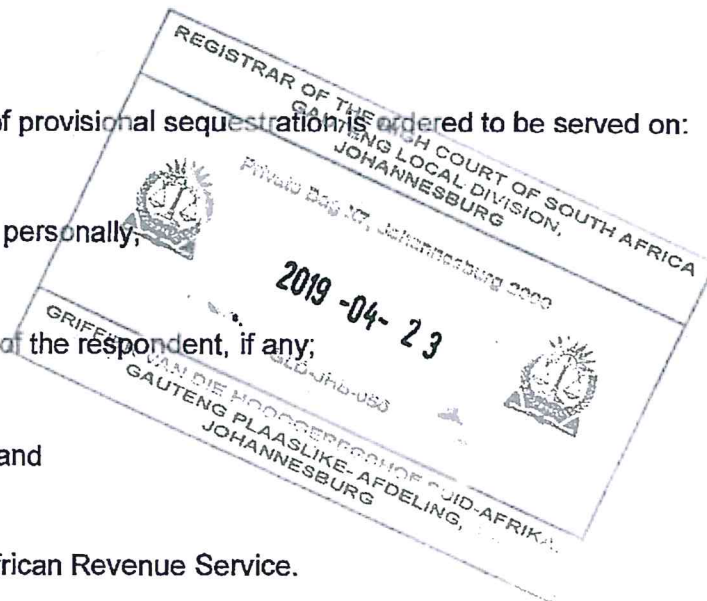
- 1. The applications set down on 23 April 2019 are enrolled as urgent applications and dealt with accordingly.

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2. The first to third intervening creditors are granted leave to intervene in the application brought by the first and second applicants (“**the applicants**”) against the respondent under the above case number (“**the sequestration application**”).
3. That the applications of the applicants and the third intervening creditor are postponed to 4 June 2019; costs reserved.
4. The application of the first and second intervening creditor is granted, and the respondent’s estate is placed under provisional sequestration, returnable on 4 June 2019; the costs to be costs in the sequestration.
5. The respondent and any other interested persons who wish to avoid such an order being made final are called upon to advance the reasons, if any, on 4 June 2019 why the Court should not grant a final order of sequestration of the respondent’s estate.

6. A copy of the order of provisional sequestration is ordered to be served on:


- 6.1. the respondent personally;

- 6.4. on the South African Revenue Service.

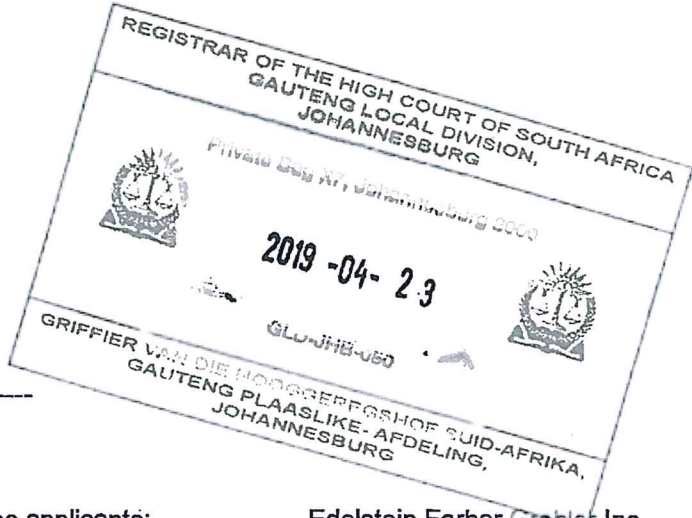


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7. The respondent's interlocutory application(s) now pending are postponed *sine die*; costs reserved.
