2. Current Status of Business Rescue Proceedings

- 2.1 The Business Rescue Practitioner (“BRP”) has in terms of Section 141(2)(a)(ii) of the Companies Act No.71 of 2008 (“the Act”) concluded that there is no reasonable prospect of rescuing the *Company* and has accordingly issued an application seeking the winding up of the affairs of the *Company*.
- 2.2 The application has been issued in the Gauteng Local Division of the High Court, Johannesburg seeking an order as contained in the Notice of Motion and was heard on 30 November 2021.
- 2.3 The judge deemed the matter to not be urgent and accordingly the application will now be allocated to the ordinary motion roll for hearing. Once a date has been allocated, we will inform affected persons accordingly.
