

2. Current Status of Business Rescue Proceedings

Kindly note: This status report must be read together with all previous status reports and that the information contained in this status report is a record of events and/or information that have transpired subsequent to the publication of the previous month's status report:

2.1 Progress on Implementation of the Adopted Business Rescue Plan

- 2.1.1 The implementation of the BR Plan has a number of conditions precedent including the renegotiation of the company's loan agreement with Grindrod Bank. Grindrod has from time to time requested an extension of the date for the completion of these conditions.
- 2.1.2 The continued extensions have prolonged the business rescue proceedings for far longer than the BRP expected. As previously reported the BRP has provided all the interested parties with an ultimatum to either conclude on the terms of the adopted BR Plan by 30 November 2024, failing which he will seek the termination of the business rescue proceedings.
- 2.1.3 Grindrod Bank has requested a further extension, based on their internal re-organisation and incorporation into African Bank. Finalisation is now expected to be by May 2025.
